- I. Select "PowerSchool Student Portal" link under STUDENTS from the district website.
- 2. Enter the same log-in credentials to log into your Chromebook
- 3. Click on the Course Request Entry icon at the left side of the portal page.

- 4. 8th grade students are required to select an art or music course. You may select an additional elective if it can fit into your schedule. Lunch and PE will be automatically requested upon submitting. It is HIGHLY RECOMMENDED that 8th grade students select Health Education to complete the health graduation requirement.

Choose courses for each subject area by clicking the pencil icon on the right. Courses chosen or preselected (such as lunch) will then display on the page. A red exclamation on the right side of the subject area indicates a required course has not yet been selected. A green check indicates a course has been selected or is not required.
